Bantam Region Playdowns

This weekend will see the first berths to the Tim Bantam Provincials declared. Regional playdowns will take place in Keewatin, Kakabeka Falls, Blind River, Sudbury (Idylwylde G&CC), and Kapuskasing. <u>Results</u>

Coaches Association of Ontario Coaching Conference:

The CAO is hosting the Ontario Coaches Conference February 20-22, 2015. The conference welcomes more than 350 amateur coaches from across the province, ranging from community volunteers to full-time professional coaches. The Conference has become a can't-miss event on the provincial sport event calendar since 2007, involving coaches from as many as 50 sporting disciplines, including those working with Olympic and Paralympic athletes.
