



The Amethyst Curling Camp will be offering bus service to and from the 2015 camp for campers travelling from the west to attend the camp via Highway 11.

The bus will leave Thunder Bay at 21:00 on Saturday, June 27th and will have tentative pick up spots at Nipigon, Geraldton, Longlac, Hearst, Kapuskasing, Smooth Rock Falls, Cochrane, and Timmins. Arrival in Sudbury will be around 11:00 on Sunday, June 28th. Campers will be allowed an early check-in to residence.

The return route will simply be the reverse with the bus leaving Sudbury at 13:00 on Friday, July 3rd. The bus will be supplied by Caribou Coach and instructors will act as chaperones for the journey.

The bus and schedule will be dependant upon the number of campers who commit to the service. The following rates will apply at each of the pick-up points. The price includes round trip fare and HST.
