We are thrilled to announce that once again, the Amethyst Curling Camp will be offering bus service to and from the 2018 camp for campers travelling from the west to attend the camp via Highway 11.

The bus will leave Thunder Bay at 21:00 on Sunday July 1st and will have tentative pick up spots at Nipigon, Geraldton, Longlac, Hearst, Kapuskasing, Smooth Rock Falls, Cochrane, Iroquois Falls, Matheson, and Englehart. Arrival in North Bay will be around 11:00 on Monday, July 2nd. Campers will be allowed an early check-in to residence.

The return route will simply be the reverse with the bus leaving North Bay at 13:00 on Friday, July 6th. The bus will be supplied by Winning Streak Charters and instructors will act as chaperones for the journey.

The bus availability and schedule will be dependent upon the number of campers who commit to the service. The following rates will apply at each of the pick-up points. The price includes round trip fare and HST.
