Competition Coach Training (16 hours – two days)

Technical – Designed to train an individual to coach a medium to advanced performance team. The 16 hour course is taught over two days and time is spent on-ice and in the classroom.

Prerequisite: None but participants should have a general knowledge of the game.

Course Content: Teaching and Learning, Strategy and Tactics, Skills Analysis, Practice Planning, including Safety and EAP (Emergency Action Plan), Delivery Skills, Brushing Skills,

Theory – a 3-hour module “Making Ethical Decisions” plus on-line evaluation available at www.coachesontario.ca. MED training helps coaches identify the legal, ethical, and moral implications of difficult situations that present themselves in the world of team and individual sport.
