## **POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST IN A CANADIAN CURLING RINK**

If a participant / staff member / volunteer has been in your rink environment, tests positive for COVID-19, has contacted a physician, and notifies your club's management, then:

1. Respect privacy laws by not publishing / sharing any details on the person in question with the exception of the local public health authority with jurisdiction.
2. Report this to the local public health authority. Please cooperate fully.
3. Inform the participant in question that they, and any member of their household, are suspended from entering the rink until medical clearance has been provided for them to safely return-to-play.
4. The local public health authority will determine all communication and the tracing of all contacts. It is vital you keep a record of everyone in your building at any given time.
