## POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST IN A CANADIAN CURLING RINK

If a participant / staff member / volunteer has been in your rink environment, tests positive for COVID-19, has contacted a physician, and notifies your club's management, then:

- 1. Respect privacy laws by not publishing / sharing any details on the person in question with the exception of the local public health authority with jurisdiction.
- 2. Report this to the local public health authority. Please cooperate fully.
- 3. Inform the participant in question that they, and any member of their household, are suspended from entering the rink until medical clearance has been provided for them to safely return-to-play.
- 4. The local public health authority will determine all communication and the tracing of all contacts. It is vital you keep a record of everyone in your building at any given time.
