


A message from the Hit Draw Tap Coordinator:

Attention Curlers! Northern Ontario Curling Association is happy to announce the return of the Hit Draw Tap Program sponsored by Tim Hortons!



Hit Draw Tap is a friendly skills competition for young Curlers to test their abilities.

As implied, contestants will get the chance to attempt three key Curling shots.

Participants will have 5 attempts for each shot and will score every rock.

Scores will be recorded and winners will receive exciting prizes!





There are three separate age groups for the Hit Draw Tap Program as of the participant's date of birth.

• Ages 6-8 (Born in 2016, 2015, 2014)

• Ages 9-10 (Born in 2013, 2012)

Ages 11-13 (Born in 2011, 2010, 2009)

Parents/Guardians will be required to sign a participant form and waiver as well as provide proof of age for participant.



- No Brushing
- Competition Rocks (No little rocks)
- Full Sheet Length (6-8 Age group uses near hack and near house)
- Participants must wear head protection if deemed necessary by club
- Participants must wear curling shoes/clean running shoes
- 2 practice stones are allowed
- Participants get a total of 5 attempts per shot
- Ties for 1st 2nd, and 3rd will be broken with a sudden death draw

Objective: Hit the positioned rock and stay in the rings!

Scoring

5 points: Shooter hits and stays on button

4 points: Shooter hits and stays on 4 foot

3 Points: Shooter hits and stays on 8 foot

2 Points: Shooter hits and stays on 12 foot

1 Point: Shooter hits and rolls out

O Points: Shooter misses target stone



Objective: Get as close to the button as possible!

Scoring

5 points: Touches the pin

4 points: Touches the button


3 Points: Touches the 4 foot

2 Points: Touches the 8 foot

1 Point: Touches the 12 foot

O Points: Misses the rings





Objective: Tap the target stone as close to the button as possible!

Scoring

5 points: Rock is tapped to the button

4 points: Rock is tapped to the 4 foot

3 Points: Rock is tapped to the 8 foot

2 Points: Rock is tapped to the 12 foot

1 Point: Rock is tapped through the rings

O Points: Target rock is missed





Each participant will receive a Hit Draw Tap Certificate signed by the club coordinator, runners up will receive ribbons, and winners from each age group receive medals.

Other prizes such as Curling swag and equipment may be available.

Based on scores, the top 5 participants from Northern Ontario will advance to the Hit Draw Tap provincial.



The top 5 Participants with the highest scores will have the opportunity to face off against one another in the Virtual Hit Draw Tap Provincial.

To save on travel costs and scheduling concerns, participants will get to film themselves performing the Hit, Draw, and Tap shots with 5 attempts per shot.

Once all results are received, a virtual event will take place combining the footage from all participants.
